

High School Principal's Board Report

1. MAP testing is finishing up this week. Students took the web based form for the first time this year in preparation for our 1:1 initiative. Next year, classroom teachers will implement the testing. Results will be presented in May.
2. Iowa Assessments were sent from the high school last week. Since the middle school received results in less than two weeks, we are expecting results to present in May.
3. The PBIS committee is working weekly on solidifying the first year plan for implementation in the fall. This will be our staff meeting focus for the remainder of the semester. Staff is given input as to rewards, reinforcements, and consequences as well as teaching and re-teaching expectations. The committee meets weekly and has put in many hours devising the first year plan. PBIS implementation takes 3 years.
4. The proposed list for graduation is attached to this board report. The students listed are on track for May graduation pending the successful completion of second semester.
5. Spring activities are in full swing. The track, golf and trapshooting teams have begun competition.
6. Seniors on IEPs were transitioned on April 8<sup>th</sup> and will continue again on April 15<sup>th</sup>. The special education staff closes out IEPs and prepares senior students in special education for their next steps. Donna Hejhal with AEA1 and Lewis Leitzel with Vocational Rehab are instrumental in these meetings.
7. The CTE department is attending the NICC advanced manufacturing and STEM day on April 15<sup>th</sup>. They will be connecting to local industry, area teachers, and NICC staff to further advance our offering as students prepare for the workplace and/or postsecondary education.
