## High School Principal's Board Report 4/8/13

- 1. MAP testing will be completed April 22-26. 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> graders completed reading, math and science during that time. Test scores will be provided when all make ups are completed.
- 2. All 9<sup>th</sup> grade students are registered for classes and Michelle Kipp is setting up PowerSchool for upperclassmen to register with her online. We will be attending a training at Grant Wood to assist with more efficient scheduling. As soon as the budget and staffing are solidified, Michelle Kipp and I will be imputing schedules. We hope to be done by June 1.
- 3. Teachers have been discussing rigor and relevant data in grade level CLT groups. Curricular CLTs are having tours at TriMark and we are scheduling visits to other businesses and industry in the community.
- 4. The proposed list for graduation is attached to this board report. The students listed are on track for May graduation pending the successful completion of second semester.
- 5. Spring activities are in full swing. The track, golf and trapshooting teams have begun competition.
- 6. Seniors on IEPs will be transitioned May 7th. The special education staff will spend the day closing out IEPs and preparing senior students in special education for their next steps. Donna Hejhal with AEA1 and Lewis Leitzel with Vocational Rehab are instrumental in these meetings.
- 7. The Career and Technical Education department has revamped their courses offerings to better meet the needs of our students, address concerns voiced by local industry and offer more transferable college credit to students. They spent two days off campus with NICC staff redesigning their offerings.
- 8. Susan Anderson and I visited two schools in Des Moines, Hoyt Middle School and Roosevelt High School, to see their RTI and IPI in action. We are currently discussing how we can implement some of the facets of their programs.
