

High School Principal's Board Report

1. 10th graders took the Accuplacer last week in two groups with an online system. We are still analyzing scores. This material can be used for all students to take community college courses. Next year, we will split up the testing quite a bit to small groups.
2. Iowa Assessments were sent from the high school last week. Since the middle school received their results in less than two weeks, we are expecting results to present to you in May.
3. The proposed list for graduation is attached to this board report. The students listed are on track for May graduation pending the successful completion of second semester along with those who finished in January.
4. Spring activities are in full swing. The track, golf and trapshooting teams have begun competition.
5. Seniors on IEPs will be transitioned on April 20th. The special education staff closes out IEPs and prepares senior students in special education for their next steps. Donna Hejhal with AEA 1, Lewis Leitzel with Vocational Rehabilitation, Bobbi Jo O'Donnell with Chickasaw County case management, and Mary Rosonke with Iowa Workforce help with on-going services.
6. We are in full preparation for graduation with little time to go. Please put graduation date, May 22, on your calendar.
7. We currently have more than 20% of our student body participating in some job experience through CLL or arranged CTE programming. The CTE and NICC advisory board will continue working on strengthening partnerships as we keep expanding this programming.
8. Mike Kuennen and I took 3 students to an Iowa BIG Hackathon on April 7 in Charles City. We will have at least one more session and take more kids before the end of the year. I will talk more about this during our meeting tonight.
