## NEW HAMPTON MIDDLE SCHOOL HONOR ROLL REGULATIONS

## Honor Roll

1. Only students who attend the New Hampton Middle School and who are enrolled in the fifth, sixth, seventh, or eighth grade are eligible.
2. All students of grades five, six, seven and eight will be considered members of the honor roll if they have a 3.0 grade point average or above for the quarter in their required academic subjects: Reading and English/ Language Arts; Mathematics, Social Studies, Science .
3. A student will not be eligible for the honor roll if he/she has a failing grade in any subject regardless of the number of grade points.
4. To figure your grade point average, each student should convert his/her letter grades to grade points, add up the numberical values, and divide by 5 , the number of academic classes.

5. A student must have a minimum of 3.00 grade point average to qualify for the Middle School Honor Roll.

## Progressive Honor Roll

1. Any student having below a 3.00 grade point average may be placed on the progressive honor roll by raising his/her grade point average earned over the previous quarter.
2. No student will be eligible for the progressive honor roll if he/she has one or more failing grades in any subject for the quarter.
