I RECEIVED INFORMATION LAST YEAR REGARDING A CHANGE IN PRICING FOR SCHOOL MEALS. IT STATED "EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2011, SECTION 205 OF THE HEALTHY, HUNGER-FREE KIDS ACT OF 2010 REQUIRES SCHOOL FOOD AUTHORITIES PARTICIPATING IN THE NATIONAL SCHOOL LUNCH PROGRAM TO PROVIDE THE SAME LEVEL OF SUPPORT FOR LUNCHES SERVED TO STUDENTS WHO ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR FREE OR REDUCED PRICE LUNCHES (I.E., PAID LUNCHES) AS THEY ARE FOR LUNCHES SERVED TO STUDENTS ELIGIBLE FOR FREE/REDUCED LUNCHES."

WHAT THIS MEANS TO US, IS WE AGAIN NEED TO RAISE OUR PRICES FOR MEALS TO SHORTEN THE GAP BETWEEN WHAT WE CURRENTLY CHARGE FOR MEALS AND THE PRICE IN WHICH WE ARE REIMBURSED. WE WILL NEED TO DO THIS OVER TIME TO HAVE THE LEAST AMOUNT OF IMPACT TO FAMILIES IN OUR DISTRICT.
