Summer School

We have nine students who will be attending summer school with Mrs. Bear beginning on July 29 – August 9. We will be using data from the Spring MAP results to focus in on individual goal strands.

Olweus Results

Ms. Wickham compiled the results from our Olweus Bullying survey with students' grades 5-8. The results indicated that unstructured areas such as the hallway and recess were where most bullying occurred. Exclusion was the most common form of bullying reported amongst girls and verbal bullying was the most common form with boys. As a middle school, we will be using the book, Wonder by R.J. Palacio, to help foster a more caring environment next year.

MAP Scores

I have attached the results of our spring MAP (Measures of Academic Progress) results. You will notice that most goals were met in reading and language arts, but not in math. Where math received stronger scores on Iowa Assessment, but MAP data did not necessarily agree. We will use this MAP data along with Iowa Assessment data to structure our RTI (Response to Intervention) groups for next year.
