BASEBALL

 As a reflection of our baseball program's successful 22-10 season, senior Jaxon Eckley and junior Braxton Bundy earned All-State honors with Eckley being only the 5th baseball player in school history to be recognized All-State two or more years. Also, Reid Rausch earned Academic All-State honors.

STRENGTH & CONDITIONING

• Under the leadership of Co-Coaches Jordan Rommes and Carter Henry, the first annual Max-Out Week took place during July 21-24 culminating in the first-ever "Power Hour" event that helped raise \$4,305 for our program.

CROSS COUNTRY

- Under the leadership of Head Coach Jamie Ohrt and her coaching staff (2), there are 28 student-athletes participating in cross country in grades 9-12 (2024: 23).
- The Chickasaw Cross Country Invitational will be held on October 9 starting at 4:15 PM at New Hampton Golf and Country Club.

FOOTBALL

- Under the leadership of Head Coach Chad Pemble and his coaching staff (7), there are 57 student-athletes participating in football in grades 9-12 (2024: 60).
- The first football game will be held at home on Friday, August 29 against Union with recognition of the Tri-Athlete Award, Friend of School Award, and New Hampton Parks & Recreation Punt-Pass-Kick Competition.

VOLLEYBALL

- Under the leadership of Coach Jessica Geerts and her coaching staff (4), there are 44 student-athletes participating in volleyball in grades 9-12 (2024: 43).
- The Chickasaw Volleyball Tournament will be held on September 6 starting at 8:00 AM.

FALL MUSICAL

• Under the leadership of Drama Director Maggie Konecne and Vocal Music Director Jill Cantu, the fall musical "Annie" will be performed on Friday, November 14 at 7:00 PM and Saturday, November 15 at 7:00 PM.

- Under the leadership of Coach Kyra Lewis, there are 7 football cheerleaders (2024: 10).
