#### **ATHLETICS**

- The **girls wrestling** team won the UIC conference title on January 24 with 3 individual conference champions Vanessa Salas (115), Kelly Throndson (140), Ava Trende (235) and Sophie Glaser (130) and Ava Trende (235) both finished in 7th place at the girls state wrestling tournament on February 6-7 marking the first time that our girls wrestling team has had more than one state place winner.
- Jax Shekleton won a conference title (150) at the last NEIC **boys wrestling** tournament ever on February 1. New Hampton hosted the district wrestling tournament on February 15 and NH/TV's state qualifiers are TBD.
- The **girls basketball** team competed in the regional playoff game at Forest City on February 14 and the **boys basketball** team competes in the district playoff game at Waukon on February 17.
