1. ISASP testing is complete and we've gotten the on demand report! Our 4th grade class made some tremendous growth this year. The grade level teachers along with our reading and math interventionists have all worked very hard this year. Fourth grade began the year at 31% proficient in ELA and 51% proficient in Math. After testing this spring they were at 72% proficient in ELA and 77% proficient in Math. They are celebrating this amazing growth with a pizza party! 3rd graders also completed their ISASP testing. This is the third graders' first time completing the test. Their grade level was 59% proficient in ELA and 54% proficient in math.
2. We had a successful turnout for both our 3 year old and 4 year old preschool graduation programs.
