Kindergarten through 4th grade students have completed their Fast Testing for Reading. We switched our process for how we were testing students to a more efficient way, allowing interventionists to work with students sooner. This also allows us to get the personalized reading plans shared with parents for student who are below benchmark and new intervention groups created.

2nd Grade: 51% Proficient

3rd Grade: 54% Proficient

4th Grade: 60% Proficient
