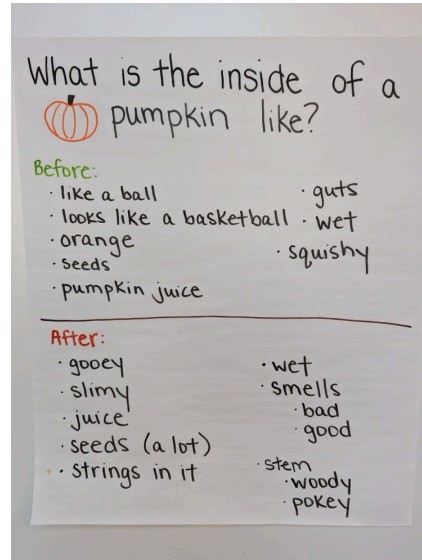


Elementary Board Report October 2024
