

Middle School Principal's Report to the Board  
August 13, 2012

1. Fifth grade orientation will be Monday, August 13<sup>th</sup>. Student will be able to find their lockers and look at their schedules before school starts.
2. New student orientation will also be Monday, August 13<sup>th</sup>. 8th grade mentors will interview students. They will take a tour of the building and also receive their schedules with their locker assignments.
3. We have one new teacher. Matt Schult will be the 5<sup>th</sup>/6<sup>th</sup> special education/social studies teacher.
4. We missed our AYP goals in reading and in special education for math. We will be looking at the data to see what specific areas in reading and math need to be targeted. We may be using an advisor time in the afternoon for intervention time with individual students.
5. The rooms on 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> floor received new blinds. The windows on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor east/west hallway were taken out.
6. We are looking at the possibility for a middle school fundraiser to generate funds for field trips related to curricular areas as well as possible assemblies.
7. I am looking to establish a parent advisory committee in September to assess the needs of the middle school.
