- Fourth grade students presented their PBL “What Bugs Me” project to community members during their gallery walk. 14 students were selected to present at the Science and Engineering Fair hosted by Keystone AEA in March.
- First grade students experienced the Starlab and had a space presentation with Mr. Monteith.
- Third grade students enjoyed a field trip to Twin Ponds.
- Fourth graders had their Agriculture Partner in Education, Joanne Tupper, come in and share about pork production. Students were also able to pet the piglets.
