The Board of Education for the New Hampton Community School District will accept bids for unleaded ethanol blend (10%) gasoline, E-80 gasoline, unleaded regular, diesel fuel, and Biodiesel for the 2020-2021 school year.

Diesel fuel will be required for 19 buses, and gasoline will be required for 10 support vehicles. Monthly usage of diesel is approximately 2,000 gallons and gas 326 gallons.

Bids are to state the District's net cost in relation to the posted price of self service fuels in New Hampton (see bid form).
