

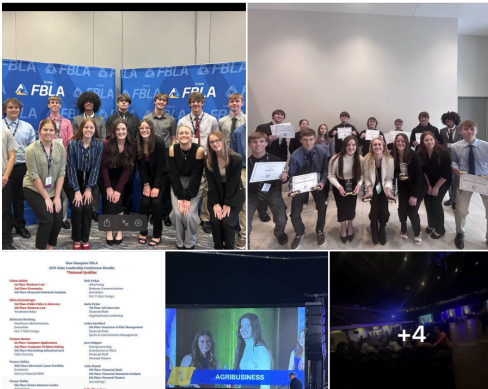
## High School Board Report April 21, 2025

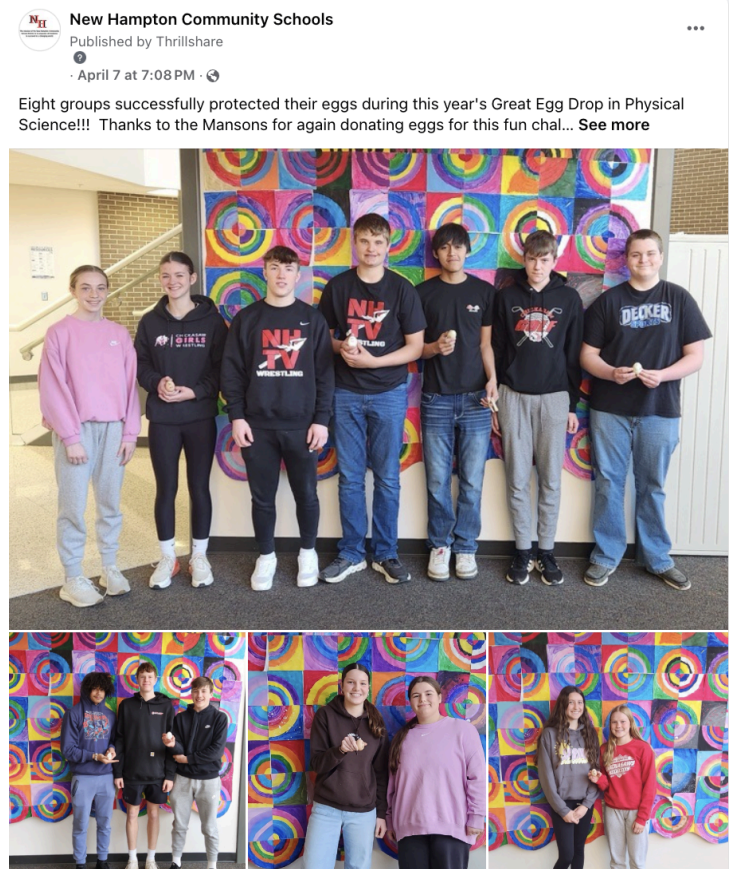
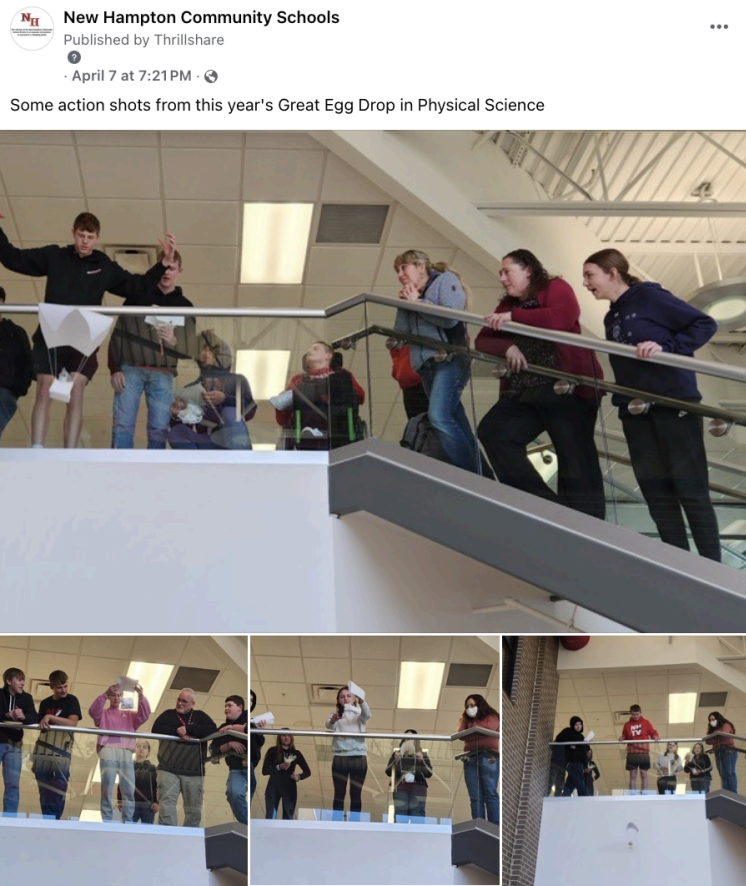

3. Science Students did their annual PBL Egg drop experiment. We had more survive this year than in years past!

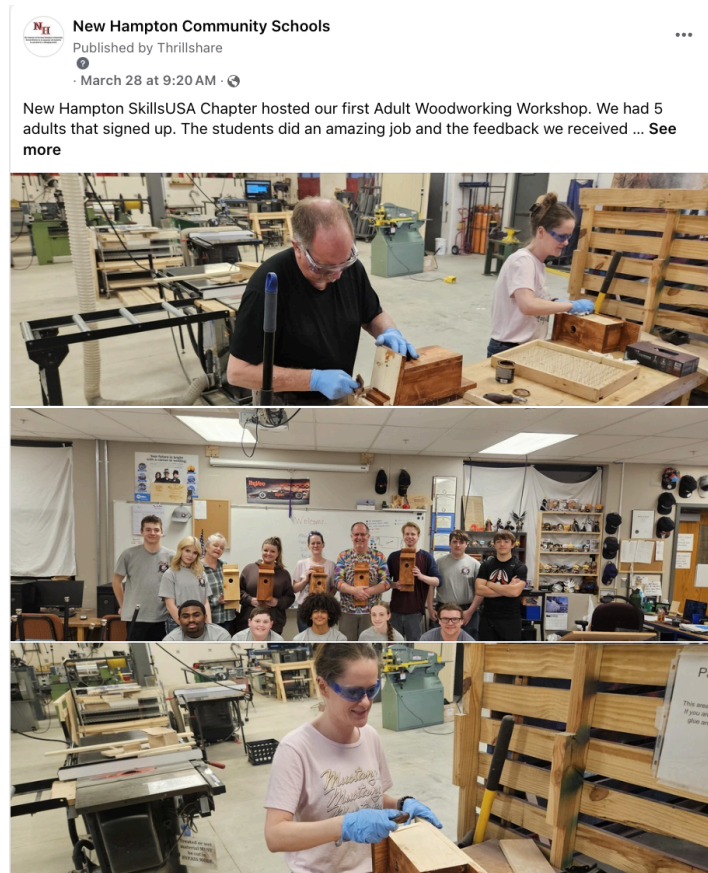


4. Our students are putting on an Art Show May 3. This is always great to see student art and celebrate our seniors!
