- ON THE FLOOR! Congratulations to sophomore Sophie Gauer (135) and freshman Ava Trende (235) for both finishing in 7th place at the girls state wrestling tournament at Corvallis's Xtream Arena on Thursday-Friday marking the first time that our girls wrestling team has had more than one state place winner.
- With JV and Varsity games on a night showcasing the youth girls basketball program, our boy and girls basketball teams picked up 4 wins against Central Springs on Thursday with senior Adam Ewert leading our boys team with 13 points in a 34-46 win while our girls team came from behind to win a 44-42 barn burner with 3 records set on the clock and pressure free throws made by junior Oliver Weigt and sophomore Ava Leitchman.

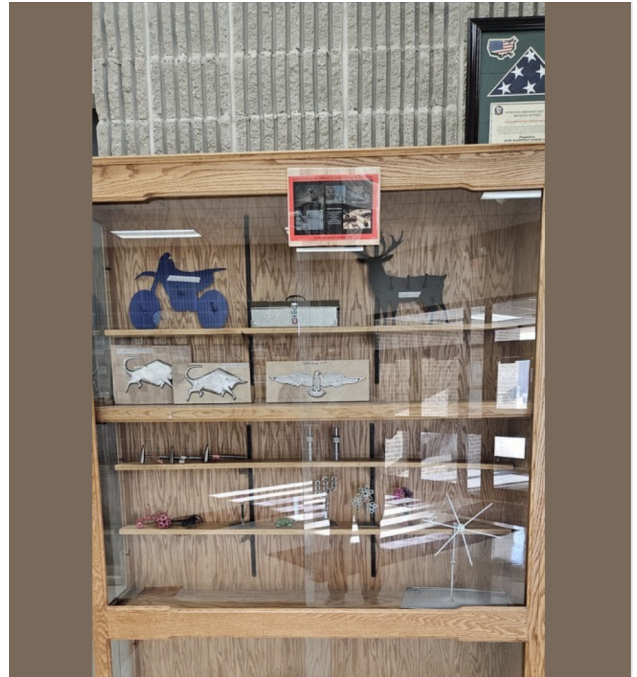
