
## High School Board Report October 21, 2024


- 1. Conferences are the week of November 4th. We look forward to meeting with our parents about student progress and helping students and parents with the next steps in their high school careers.










7. Our FCCLA students participated in a Fall Leadership Rally at the Kirkwood Hotel.
