

1. We had an Assembly put on by NextEra, the kids really enjoyed this as it was an interactive assembly with song and dance. They brought an important message of "Being and MVP" (Knowing you Matter, You have Value, and You have a Purpose).
2. Our Professional Development day on November 13th was devoted to work time for PBL, going over our school index report card, and having some teacher work time to look at how the next month will go before semester ends. We continued to strengthen our social emotional capacities with the work from our health leadership team.
3. 8th Grade Career Week was very successful. Students were able to have some seeds planted on some great career opportunities right here in New Hampton and the surrounding area. Learning how to fill out a job application and experiencing a face-to-face interview was a really good thing for our 8th graders. Students hired enjoyed a meal at the Pincion sponsored by the Chamber this year while others enjoyed Subway. See Pictures attached
4. Parent teacher conferences went very well this year. Conferences were up from last year with an overall average this fall of (79%) the same as in 2022 also 2021 - 76%, & 2020 - 83%.
5. Intervention update - these are going very well, students are receiving small group interventions in skill areas that need growth. Group sizes range from 1-19. IXL software is being used with just over 1,504 hours run time and over 207,000 (88,000 - 2022) questions answered and 9,026 skills developed that are proficient or mastered.
6. 6th - 8th students enjoyed a dance after Parent Teacher Conferences and had a lot of fun. Thank you to Mr. Rude's intervention for planning and for the generous donations brought in by parents.
7. KWIK STAR - I want to congratulate our kids and say thank you to all that supported our kids and middle school. Total sales were over \$145,000 dollars. This makes this the best year we have ever had with this fundraiser on date. Students will be so excited to earn an additional ½ day of Outfly for selling over our small goal of \$125,000. Students that sold over \$1,000 will enjoy a pizza party and some cooperative game time at the Main Event Center on Main Street on 12/6.
8. Staff is working really hard at the middle school and it's easy to tire with the changing of the season and falling back in time but we are pushing forward because it is 5 weeks to the end of the semester.
