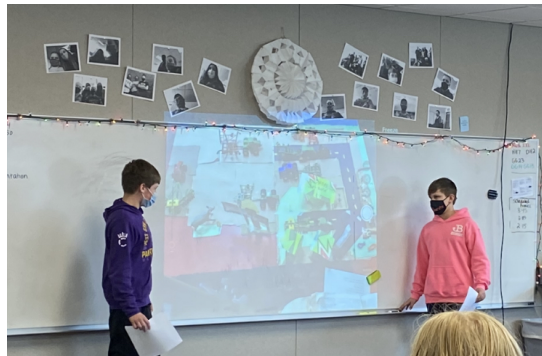


April 15, 2021
