

Middle School Board Report August 18, 2025

1. We have been working hard building student schedules and teachers have done a great job moving items back around in their rooms. I need to give a shout out to the custodians who have been moving stuff back and forth (including setting up a whole new classroom from special education). The Middle School building looks great inside and out with floors, windows, trimming all taken care of.
2. Registration is going well, we have 80% complete (258 students) at the Middle School as of 8/14/2025.
3. We welcomed new staff on the 18th, Summer Knight (8th ELA), Jessica Nelson (District Special Education Director), and hopefully some approved paraprofessionals from today's meeting.
4. Teachers first day back will be the 19th. We will have a staff meeting to discuss our updated implementation of PBIS in the Middle School. We will discuss curriculum and interventions like our 2nd year of Achieve3000 and how we can continue to use the data to make educational improvements across grade levels. A lot of work will continue around LETRS training as well.
5. We have a middle school open house scheduled from 4:00 - 6:00 with a 5th Grade Orientation taking place from 5:00 - 6:00 on the 20th. Students and parents will get a chance to hear from grade level teachers, get a chance to walk their schedules, check the building out again, practice their padlocks, and drop their items off in their lockers for the first day of school.
6. Middle School sports will start on the first FULL day of school 8/27. Fall camps went well and we should have some nice participation numbers to start the year.
7. PBIS expectations will be gone over on the first two couple days of school, students will also go through their technology bootcamp to manage their devices. The 5th grade iPads and cases are here and ready to go. Thank you for getting those ordered for the kids and to Mr. Cantu and Theo for getting them ready for student use.
8. Thrillshare/Webpage: I think it has been a great central location for the community to get information, Thanks Kyle Hennessy for getting information out there and keeping this up to date for the district.
9. Kwik Star Cards: We need to put an order in for them to start the year as all remaining cards were sold this summer. This will be our fundraiser this year again and we will look to sell them starting the last week of October. These cards can be used at the pay at the pump.
10. As a staff this year we will continue to improve our building culture with students, be our best each day & motivate all learners. We look forward to implementing PBL into our classrooms & increasing community engagement.
