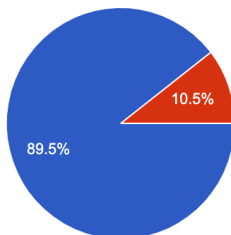

Do you feel there is at least one staff member that cares about you?

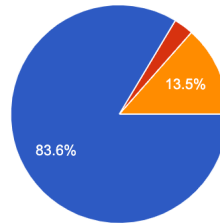

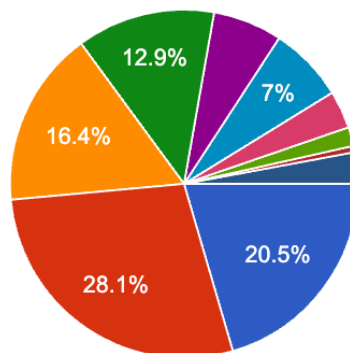

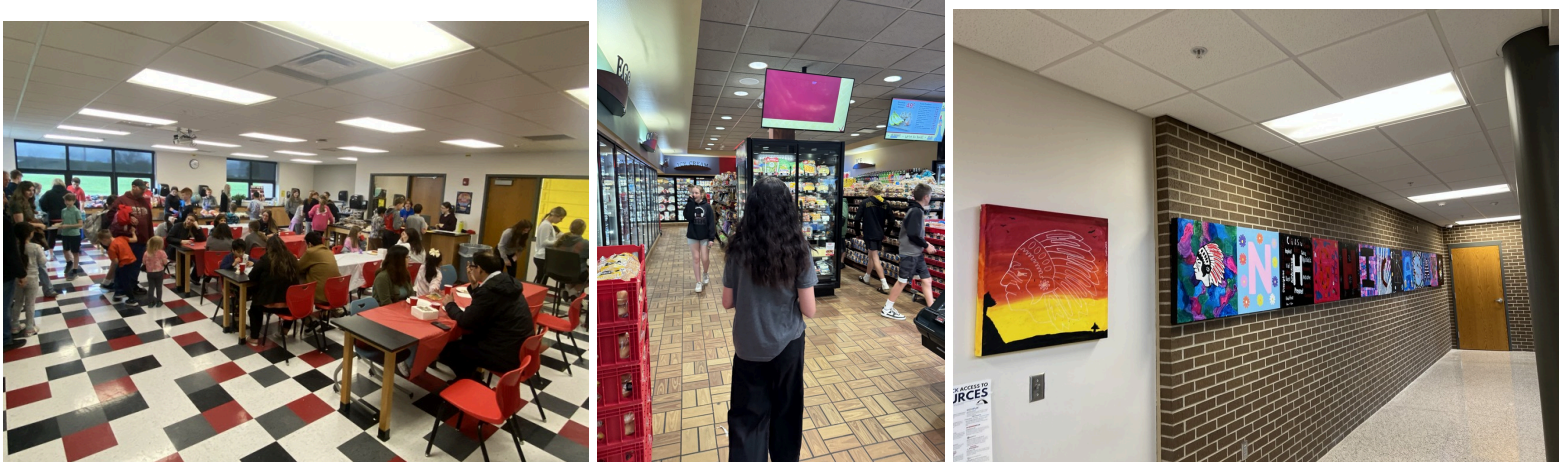

5. Rocket Day will launch this week as our 8th graders wait with anticipation to calculate which rocket will reign above the rest. (Pictures from last year)

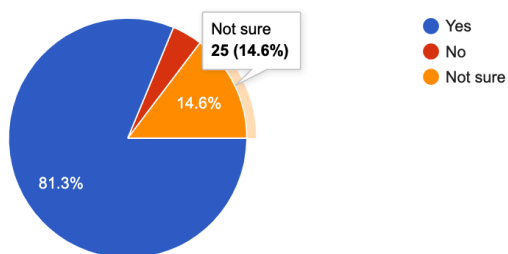

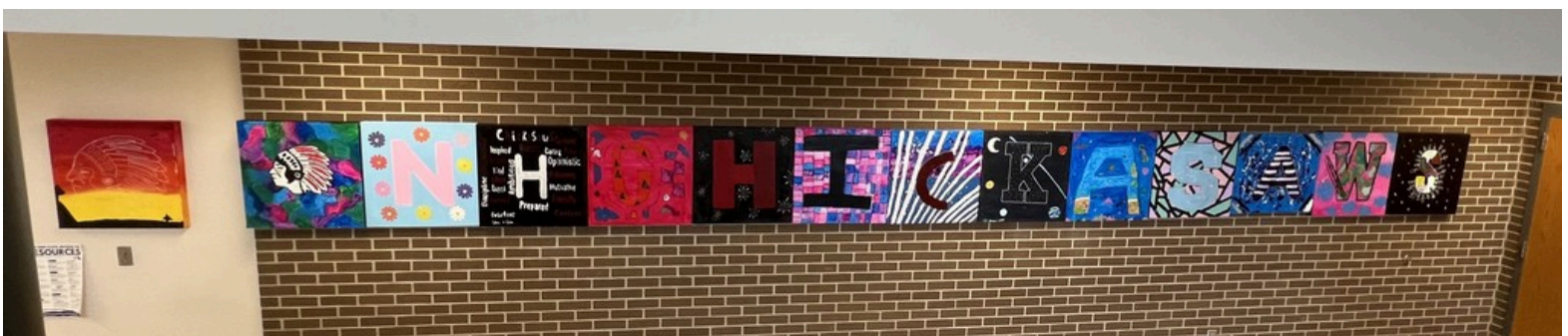
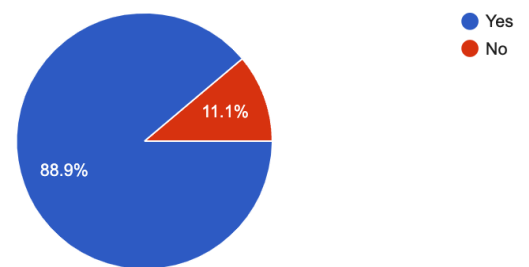
Do you think Endmester is beneficial in a way that you learned or explored something new/different?
