1. We began the year with the Kwik Star fundraiser selling \$76,580 which we receive 10%. By waiting until September 1, we were able to take advantage of their special promotion of 10% up front with more to come when spent inside the store. This is up from the normal 5% we have gotten initially in the past. With this money we plan to use it to fund various PBIS activities and other educational opportunities for our students.
