- 1. Kwik Star Fundraiser Last year the focus was to purchase team games/activities the students could play within their homerooms. Students have been doing a great job keeping these items in good shape and they still get used at the end of the day during Tribe Time. This year we plan to take trips again to enhance our learning opportunities, trips have been planned for Norman Borlaug Inspire day, Mississippi Riverfront Museum, Twin Ponds, etc. Last year, we sold Kwik Star cards in the office and didn't have the kids go out and sell it. This year the goal is to sell in November, most likely the first week, so a check can be approved at the November school board meeting and cards can be ordered and passed out in December. In 2019 the fundraiser was very successful and netted \$7,533.
- 2. Homecoming Festivities are planned by our CLT (Chickasaw Leadership Team. Students have been working with their door decorations, planning our assembly fun, and other spirited games that can be included throughout our instructional day. Last year we had a virtual assembly for Homecoming so the students are excited this year for Redi Whip pies in the face and homeroom challenges.







- 3. Teachers began the fall screeners for aMath and aReading, this lets teachers talk amongst their grade level plc's in making sure students are in the best fit intervention. We will talk more about interventions during Monday's professional development as the 6 week for interventions will be 10/7. Checking to make sure progress is happening is important as we push all students to achieve their highest potential.
- 4. IXL Science was purchased to go along with reading and math. So far Mrs. Rodgers has been using it as an extended learning tool with her 7th grade students who have answered 4,150 questions so far this year. In reading students this year grades 5-8 almost 500 questions have been answered and in math students have answered just over 48,000 questions. IXL has been great for student engagement also outside the classroom as 66 hours have been spent on the program outside of the school to go along with the 332 hours during the school.
