- 1. Kwik Star Fundraiser The focus in the past has been to purchase team games/activities the students could play within their homerooms. Students have been doing a great job keeping these items in good shape and they still get used at the end of the day during Tribe Time. This year we plan to take trips again to enhance our learning opportunities, trips have been planned for Norman Borlaug Inspire day, Mississippi Riverfront Museum, Twin Ponds, etc. In 2023, we sold over \$145,000 dollars in Kwik Star cards, our goal last year will be to sell \$150,000 dollars in cards. Who knows where they will want to set the bar this year. Cards can be used directly at the pump so that has been beneficial. This year the goal is to sell at the end of October Early November, so a check can be approved at the November school board meeting and cards can be ordered and passed out in December. This fundraiser has been successful netting upwards to \$7500 for the middle school to use on these various learning opportunities.
- 2. Homecoming Festivities are being planned by our CLT (Chickasaw Leadership Team. Students have been working with coordinating dress up days, planning our assembly fun, and other spirited games that can be included throughout our instructional day.
- 3. Teachers began the fall screeners for aMath and aReading, and have administered the level set for Achieve3000 this allows teachers to talk amongst their grade level plc's in making sure students are in the best fit intervention. We will talk more about interventions during October's professional development as the 6 week mark for our first round of interventions will be 10/15. Checking to make sure progress is happening is important as we push all students to achieve their highest potential.
- 4. CLT Team members ran a concession stand at our 7th grade volleyball game and practiced leadership skills. Thank you team members and to Missy Sinnwell and Hannah Bonde for supervising.
