1. Anne Frank Performance – Nancy Edgar Park Square Theater, St Paul, Minnesota

During third quarter literacy class in 8th grade students read the dramatization of *The Diary of Anne Frank* by Frances Goodrich and Albert **Hackett.** This piece of classic literature is featured in the majority of 8th grade level textbooks, including our *Prentice Hall Literature* currently used. In addition to College & Career Readiness Anchor Standards this trip specifically ties to the following Common Core Standard at the 8th grade level: Integration of Knowledge and Ideas

Standard 7. Analyze the extent to which a filmed or live production of a story or drama stays faithful to or departs from the text or script, evaluating the choices made by the director or actors. (RL.8.7.)
