

Middle School Student Leadership

Teams

Copy Room (12 Max - rotate) Dixie Zeien Grades 5-8

This group of students will assist with delivering copies to the needed teachers under the direction of the copy room. We will rotate it b/w the four quarters. Four students will assist each quarter.

Homecoming Team (12 Max - three from each grade level 5-8) MS Office

This group of students will help organize Homecoming week and the activities associated with it.

Technology (5 Max- year grades 7/8) Mr. Cantu

This group of students will work with Mr. Cantu on reimaging the iPads and taking care of technology needs. Students will work the entire year with him.

8th Grade Video (3 Max - Grade 8) Mrs. Laures

This group of students will work on designing the 8th grade video. They will scan pictures in and then begin putting the pictures and music together for the video under the direction of Mrs. Laures.

Library/Media Center (8 students max: Grades 5-8) Mrs. Hruska

This group of students will assist in the library media center with organization of materials. They will be under the direction of Mrs. Hruska. Rotate quarterly

Battle of the Books (8 students max: Grades 7/8) Mrs. Burgart

This group of students will assist Mrs. Burgart with the organization of materials for battle of the books. They will help coach teams and work with the different groups.

Shredders (8 students max - rotate quarterly Grades 5-8) - MS Office

This group of students will complete shredding for the office as needed. They will report to the middle school office. Rotate quarterly

Announcements Team (12 max- rotate quarterly Grades 5-8): MS Office

In charge of reading announcements. Students will work to create a rotating calendar.

Recognition Team (12 max - three from each grade level grades 5-8) : One grade level teacher representative

This group will work with _____ to promote the accomplishments and participation of NHMS students. This will include students of the month. They will organize the student of the month bulletin board.

Spirit Club (12 max grades 5-8):

Promoting school activities through signage, announcements, and encouragement to participate and attend school activities. This group would also continue the locker/gym participation signs.

Character Counts Week (8 max - grades 5-8) Ms. Wickham

This group will help Ms. Wickham in the planning and organizing of CC Week.

Lost and Found (12; ideally 3 students per grade level grades 5-8): MS Office

This group will help organize the lost and found in the cafeteria and find ways track down owners of lost items.

Yearbook Team--Mrs. Edgar (max 12) (grades 7/8)

Begins at the beginning of the year approximately and will continue throughout the school year. Need a core team of students who will organize and then find additional yearbook staff to help each of them. Meets occasionally at Study Hall or Lunch. Must be responsible to check email and respond.

Book Club-- (12 Max NHMS grades 5-8) Mrs. Pfaffle

Meets twice per month during lunch period. Will discuss and recommend books. May create posters and bookmarks for NHMS. Will set up special book/reading displays. Will promote special reading/author events.

Bleacher Creatures: (12 Max NHMS grades 5-8) Mr. Schmitt/Activity Supervisor

This group will be in charge of helping to clean up after a sporting events here at the middle school. Preferably town students. Students will be supervised by whoever is on duty at that event.

Maintenance Crew: Mr. Bear (8 students Max grades 5-8)

This group will aid our custodians in moving tables, picking up trash, or whatever clean-up needs there might be. They will rotate on a quarterly basis.

Hallway Helpers: (8 students Max - 5th/6th grade) - Ms. Snyder/Mrs. Geerts

This group will aid the 5th and 6th homeroom teachers with hanging student work, creating bulletin boards, passing out items, etc.

Service Team (12 max / 6 per semester grades 5-8):

This group will come up with school-wide service project(s). www.learningtogive.org resource for semester activities.

Recycling Group (24 Max - rotate quarterly grades 5-8): MS Office

This group will be in charge of recycling each quarter.

Mentors (10 students Max: 7th/8th students only): Ms. Wickham

This group will consist of 10 or so students who assist 5th and 6th grade students during A/A on a daily basis. Rotate quarterly

Ambassadors (12-14 students grades 5-8) MS Office

This group will consist of 5-8 grade students who will assist with special event nights, such as recitals, concerts. They may pass out programs, be greeters or assist in any way to prepare for that night as well as during the event, itself.

7th/8th Hallway Helpers (8-10 Max - grades 7th/8th): Mr. Rude/Mr. Huff

Students will assist in hanging and showcasing student artwork, bulletin boards, etc.. This will include 7th and 8th graders.

Classroom Critters (max 30) grades 5-8:

5th Grade - Monteith; 6th Grade Schult; 7th Grade Gray; 8th Grade Cannon

This group will consist of 5th - 8th graders who will help teachers within their classrooms, for example: filling papers, bulletin boards, rearrange the room, bookshelf organizations, etc.

After School Aides (15 Max preferably town students grades 6-8) Mrs. Bear

Students will pick one night of the week to assist in the after school program with Mrs. Bear. They will help work with students and tutor individual students as needed.

Cafeteria Help (32 Max grades 5-8) - Cooks

This group of students will assist at the end of their lunch shifts. They will pick up the cafeteria and assist the cooks in anything that is needed. Rotate it quarterly.

Elementary Buddies(12 students Max - grades 6-8) Ms. Wickham

This group of students will assist in elementary classrooms as needed. They may read one-on-one with students, help teachers organize materials etc)

New Student Assistants (8 Students - two from each grade level grades 5-8) MS Office

This group of students will assist when new students move into the district. They will give them a tour and help answer any questions.

Music Managers (8 students - grades 5-8)

This group will be in charge of downloading and running music for different activities and music in the lunchroom.

8th Grade DC Video (4 Max - Grade 8) Mr. Rude

This group of students will work on designing the 8th grade video from Washington, DC. They will load the pictures in and begin putting music and pictures together for the video under the direction of Mr. Rude.
