## 1. Kwik Star Sales

We started the year off with Kwik Star sales, which produced our highest sales ever at \$70,850, which we receive 5% of. We will be using it to fund a Respect Retreat at the 5<sup>th</sup> grade level as well as sending the 5<sup>th</sup> grade to the Iowa State Capitol.

Seven middle school staff members will be attending PBIS training this year at Decorah. We are in our first year of full implementation. We spent the first day of school teaching students the expectations in the different areas. We also did this as a staff prior to training students which really cleaned up a few areas in terms of supervision and expectations.
