Goal #2: Inform students and parents about concurrent enrollment opportunities that New Hampton offers

- In the 2024-2025 school year, the following courses were offered as in-person courses (NICC) taught by New Hampton Teachers: Stats, Human Anatomy I. Human Anatomy II, Principles of Agronomy, Survey of Animal Industry, Marketing, Management, Business Ethics, Business Law, Art Appreciation. We also offer a variety of Hybrid courses with NICC teachers such as Composition I, Composition II, Public Speaking, Intro to Psychology, CNA, and EMT.
- In 2025-2026 school year, we will continue to promote our Early Childhood partnership with our local daycare, our Welding Apprenticeship, EMT and Health Care strands, Auto, Carpentry, Computer Technology, Heavy Equipment Operator, and CDL.
- In the 2023-2024 school year, 119 students took NICC concurrent classes
- In the 2024-2025 school year, 142 students took NICC concurrent classes
 - Continue to students and parents about these concurrent enrollment opportunities through information sessions at P/T conferences, district newsletters, and information sessions with students.


