7i. We've previously talked about ways to improve our communication with our parents and patrons and how we can better get our story out to the community. Apptegy was recommended to me by the Superintendent at Central of Elkader. They create an app that our patrons, students, and community members can download to their phone and have all the information they need about the district. It also allows our principal and/or staff to post things to our Website, Facebook, Twitter all at the same time with one app on their phone. I will share some data at the board meeting about cell phone use and our Facebook pages and also some other information on the app. It is quite expensive, but the schools I've talked to who are using are clearly in favor of it.
