- 4c. Financial Reports Look good. Year to date expenses are down in the general fund, but we've really only had one month of operation so expect that to change.
- 4e. Mr. Schmitt recommends Parker Bolt as 9<sup>th</sup> Grade boys basketball coach and the following volunteer coaches: Chris Paulus HS Wrestling and Mike Kuennen and Cory McDonald for High School boys basketball.
- 9a. We need to approve the pay applications for the month.
- 9b. We need to approve a School Budget Review committee request for allowable growth for open enrolled out students (\$19,992) who weren't here last year and for ELL students beyond their 5<sup>th</sup> year of instruction (\$14,819.20). These amount could change by board time, though it's very unlikely.
- 9c. Mrs. Lansing would like to do a fundraiser with Schwan's Food Service to assist with deficit preschool tuition accounts. I recommend we approve this.
- 9d. With the addition of North Butler, Riceville, and Turkey Valley our IBN agreement has changed. The only changes from the one previously approved is the addition of these partner schools. I recommend we approve this.
- 9e. We need to approve the student teaching/field experience agreement with ISU.
- 9f. We need to approve the agreement with Medical Enterprises for our drug testing for our bus drivers.
- 9g. The wrestlers have been invited to "The Clash" wrestling tournament in Rochester, MN. It will take place on January 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> and includes some very good teams from Minnesota, Iowa, Illinois, and Wisconsin. Since it's out of state it needs the board's approval.
