This year through lowa BIG North, we decided to create a new initiative: S.N.A.P. It is centered around the Chickasaw County Humane Society also known as S.N.A.P. With the help of Gayla Hugeback, who runs the organization, we have been able to accomplish many things. We made an Instagram profile to expand S.N.A.P.'s advertising, we installed new doors at the pound for the dogs who are too scared to go through the old metal ones, helped with promoting and bringing awareness to their Fat Head and Can Food Drive this winter, as well as visited the facility to offer companionship to pets waiting to be fostered.
