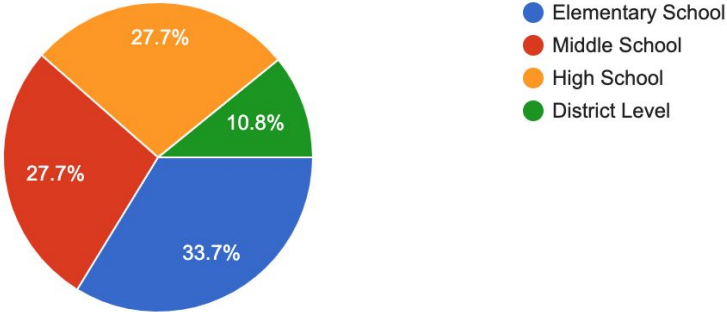


2019-2020 School Calendar Survey Data

What building do you primarily work in?



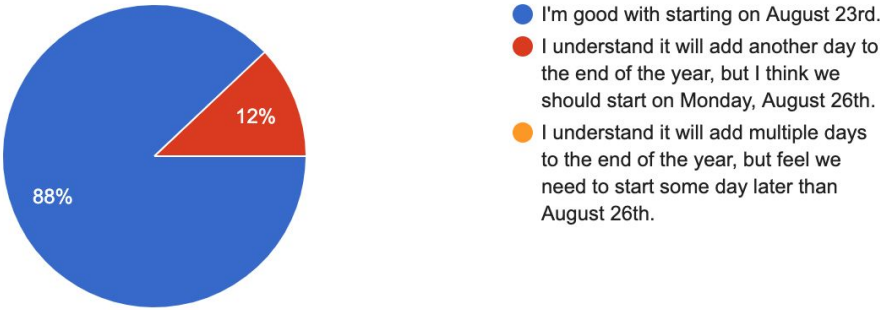

Considering the start day, August 23rd, please select the option that matches your feelings the best.

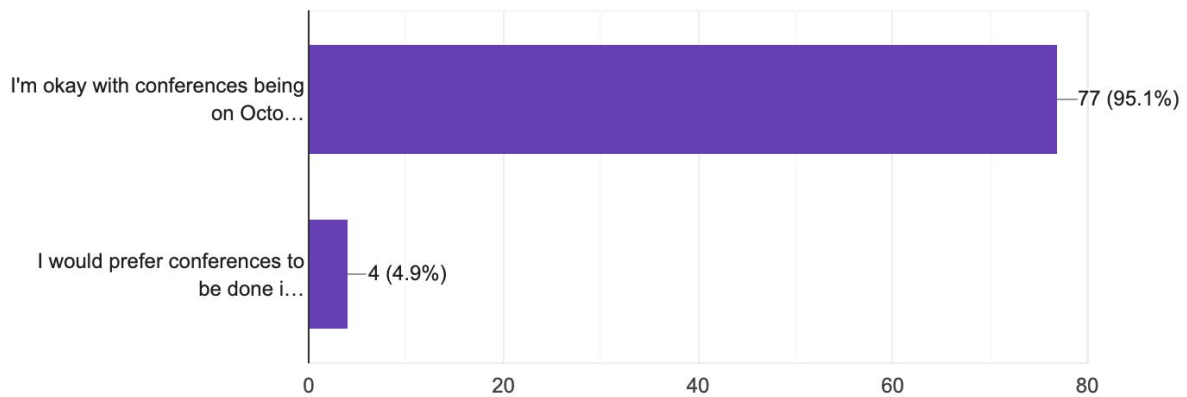

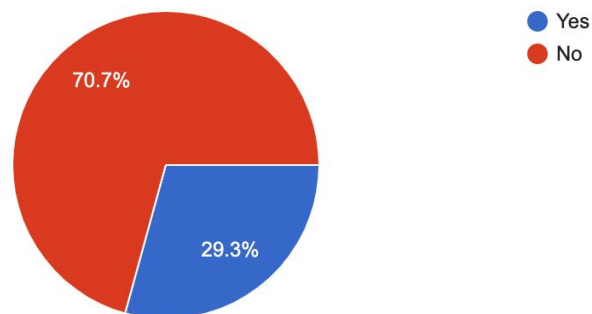

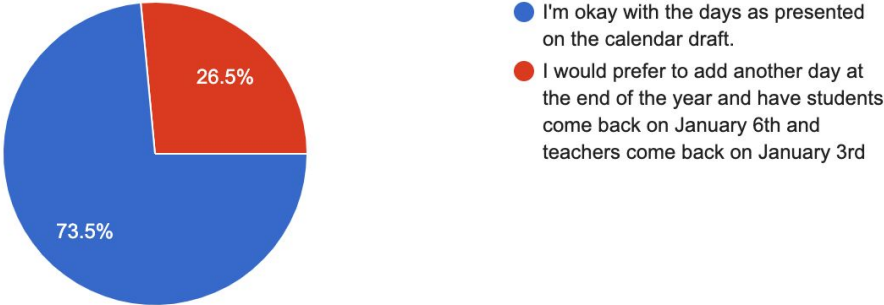

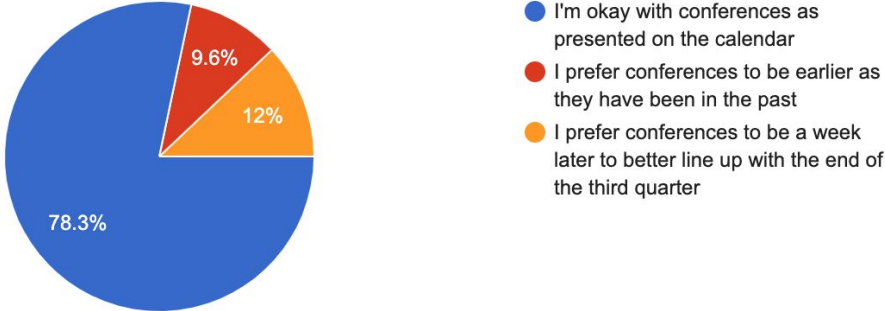
Looking again at Christmas Break, we have teachers coming back January 2nd and students on Friday, January 3rd. Please make the choice that best matches your thoughts on these dates.

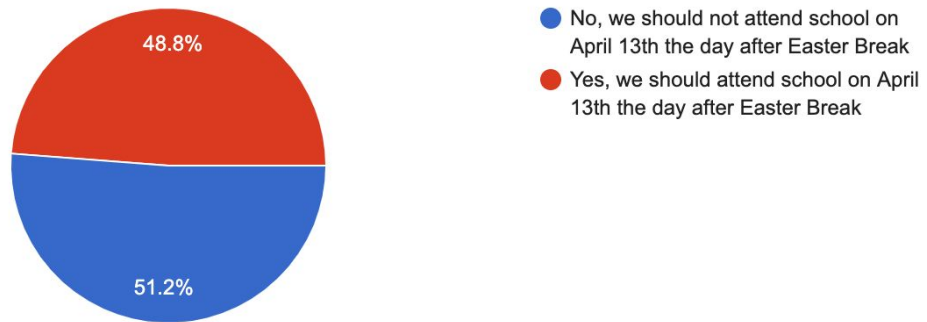
Looking at spring conferences, they were moved back several weeks to allow time to get more work in the grade books and have more things to talk about with parents.

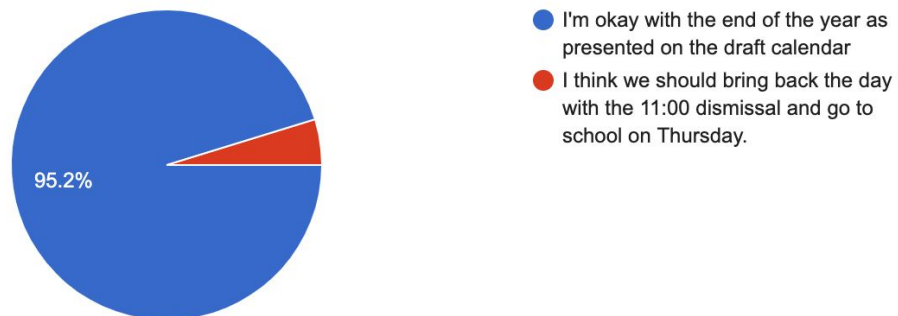

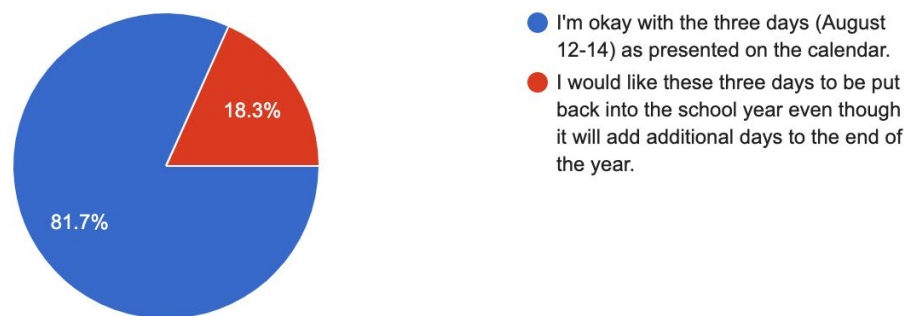
