Director Matthews moved to close the special session. Director Schwickerath seconded the motion. Ayes: Baltes, Denner, Schwickerath, Matthews, and Rosonke. Nays: none.

The Board of Directors for the New Hampton Community School District met in a Joint Work session with Turkey Valley School, Monday, February 4, 2019 in the High School Media Center. President Rosonke called the meeting to order at 7:05 pm with directors Schwickerath, Matthews, Denner, Baltes, Student Rep Maas, Superintendent Jurrens, and Board Secretary Ayers present.

Superintendent Jurrens presented financial information for New Hampton Schools and Turkey Valley Schools. Jurrens reviewed both districts unspent authorized budget for the year's FY 16, 17, and 18. Jurrens reviewed the impact of sharing staff for both District. New Hampton received \$240,677 and Turkey Valley received \$195,144. Operational sharing was \$141,456 for New Hampton and \$144,858 for Turkey Valley. Sharing has been beneficial for both districts. Jurrens reviewed the certified enrollment. In 2014 New Hampton had 970.3 students and in 2018 New Hampton had 940.58 students. Turkey Valley had 361.2 students in 2014 and 343.15 students in 2018. Both districts are seeing declining enrollment to continue in the future.

Jurrens some talking points for the board members to discuss. Jurrens believes that both districts need to continue to look for ways to share more staff as there is not a limit on sharing staff.

Jurrens asked the boards to discuss ways to bring the districts together by sharing operational services such as business functions, building functions, TLC programs, and can the districts combine some resources to make both district better and more efficient.

Jurrens asked the boards to find efficiencies that would have minimal impact on students, such as common school calendar, sharing activities such as wrestling and possible soccer.

The boards talked with each other about possibilities of sharing more staff. The FCS program is the most pressing issue now for Turkey Valley. Their current need is for a half time teacher. Due to the shortage of these teachers it appears a half time person will not be found. Jurrens informed the board that five students will be graduating this spring, all have accepted positions with district's that gave them signing bonuses.

Following the discussion, the two boards toured the New Hampton Middle School addition.

Director Matthews moved to adjourn at 8:06 pm. Director Baltes seconded the motion. Ayes: Schwickerath, Denner, Baltes Matthews, and Rosonke. Nays: none.
