Relationships

Goal: All grade level homerooms will present a lesson once a year to all other homerooms at that grade level. This presentation will amount to 1 hour of student service required for graduation. A student can accumulate 4 hours of student service by the completion of their senior year to count toward the 11 required hours for graduation.

S (Specific)

Who? Each homeroom, 2-3 students will be assigned to each other grade level homeroom

What? To accomplish teaching communication skills, develop a sense of community, empower leadership skills, develop empathy to build relationships between students and teachers

Where? Students will prepare during the homerooms of the month before their presentation and present during the assigned time of the month during homeroom.

When? Lessons will begin in November and continue through April. Teachers and homerooms will receive a schedule during the first week of school.

M (Measurable)

Did it happen? Did students meet rubric goals? The rubric must be intentional to show success.

Survey money in May for students to complete regarding presentations

A (Attainable)

Yes—students will be able to submit ideas if they want to stray from assigned lesson for the month

R (Realistic)

Convincing staff of the change may be difficult—we will provide support through administration, counselor, staff without homerooms, experts from outside the building

T (Timely)

Preparing by October and done by May 15
