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Yes. We will limit funding to what is necessary to close the claim. If the claim can be closed by prohibiting basements within the contaminated area, then we will limit funding to the approximate costs of putting the EC on the property. When that amount is reached through either implementing the EC or monitoring, we will then close the claim. If they choose the monitoring approach, then the monitoring costs above and beyond the costs of an EC will be theirs to cover.
